	<ul> <li>(*Total income = precept + forecast VAT refunds reclaimable)</li> <li>To prevent falling in to deficit at the end of FY 25/26 a 12.6% increase in the precept to £ £4143 is required in the event of an uncontested election, and a 25% increase to £4600 should a contested election take place.</li> <li>It was voted that, with the aim of safeguarding against a deficit at the end of FY 25/26, it was necessary to set the precept at £4150, a 12% increase on FY 24/25, this being caused by the 80% increase in the statutory election administration charge that will be applied in 2025, it being an election year for the PC.</li> <li>Cllr Lapper abstained from voting.</li> </ul>
