2024/53	<p><b>Planning Applications:</b>  <b>Erection of new clubhouse to replace existing Portakabin structure at Clee Hill Rugby Club</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Application supported in principle</li> <li>- While the development falls outside Nash Parish boundary, concerns raised regarding the likely increase in on-road parking and subsequent safety hazard that will arise with increased usage of the rugby club affecting residents in Knowle, which is inside the parish</li> <li>- Suggestions to mitigate this, to be included in the response to the application, include extending the 30mph speed limit, a roadside speed check sign coming from Nash direction and double yellow lines</li> <li>- While no representations have been made to Nash PC from residents concerning the development, it was agreed to seek a meeting as soon as possible with the rugby club Chair, Treasurer and President to discuss this in more detail, to be organized by Cllr Huffer</li> <li>- Cllr Huffer also agreed to raise the road safety hazard with Shropshire Council Highways dept and report back</li> </ul>	<p><u>Clerk</u></p> <p><u>Cllr Huffer</u></p> <p><u>Cllr Huffer</u></p>

2024/55	<p><b>Any Other Business: Grass Cutting</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SC circulated its grass cutting programme for 2024 after meeting agenda circulated. Nash was not listed in its proposed programme, on which neighbouring parishes are listed, and serious safety concerns were raised regarding visibility on Nash parish roads/lanes due to excessive growth of vegetation as the result of the weather</li> <li>Cllr Huffer to confirm with SC and report back on what its proposal is with regards to verge/vegetation management in Nash</li> <li>The Environmental Maintenance Grant was mentioned as a possible source to fund this and to be looked in to for next meeting</li> </ul>	<p><u>Cllr Huffer</u></p> <p><u>Clerk</u></p>
